Bridge of Love is a non-profit organisation and a registered UK Charity. It is a community based Christian outreach work of Emmanuel Tamil Christian Fellowship (ETCF). Rev G I Ebenezer is our Chairman.

This Trust was set up in 2003 for the purpose of protecting and supporting those who are oppressed especially widows and orphans, poor & needy, war victims and the persecuted. The trust confines itself to community development in the northern and eastern provinces of Sri-Lanka and the tribal areas in Tamil Nadu, South India.

Summary

· Over the past 7 years we sent more than £200,000 for our projects, which includes £30,000 Tsunami relief and around £40,000 War relief. More than 65% of this money was donated by members of this ETCF. We also produce CDs and organise events to raise funds for the Charity.

Widows, orphans, poor & needy, young offenders, child labour victims and Aid victims.

· We provide regular monthly financial support to more than eighty (80) children and thirty (24) widows in Sri Lanka & India.

· We support financial assistance and spiritual support Aids Victims in Kulathur, Chennai through Sis Indhu (6 women and more than 20 children)

Income Generating projects

· Bridge of love has trained more than 77 poor widows and donated new sewing machines worth more than Rs 1,600,000 since December 2005.

Educational projects

· We run an Evening Study programme for the Slum children in Pittakodde, Colombo.

(We are renting a hall to conduct educational and religious activities for these people who live in a slum area where there is neither electricity nor educational care available).

· We annually provide Study materials for more than 800 poor children as Christmas presents.

· Bridge of Love carried out around £30,000 worth Tsunami relief projects

· Bridge of love has sent around £40,000 worth Relief for war victims in Sri Lanka since Sep 2006. We provided emergency provisions, water facilities, food parcels, clothes, milk powders, soaps, suitcases, nutritional, medical, educational & spiritual assistance to 1000s recent war victims in Jaffna, Vavuniya and Mannar districts. Rev Vasanthan, Rev Jothy Hoole, Rev Navendranugoolan and Jaffna YMCA coordinated these relief projects.

· We provided regular financial support for 30 internally displaced families who were displaced more than 6 times during the recent war, for a two-year period.

- Bridge of Love donated Rs 450,000 for the War orphans at Canaan IDP children Home in Jaffna.

Providing emergency relief and rebuilding the future of the 1000s of broken and shattered War victims is our current main goal.
